# **Rules and Regulations – Changes for 2023**

This document highlights the major changes in the Central Coast Football Rules and Regulations for 2023. This is intended as a guide to help outline the key differences.

# **General Changes**

 All references to Average Points and game cancellations removed when calculating ladders & results of matches. *Reason: 2022 one-off rule.*

# **Player Movement Changes**

• Womens Substitution Rules W18A players can play into any WAA team. *Reason: There is generally only ever a W18A competition, and players are restricted by this. Club Requested Change* 

# Specific Rule Reference: 2.3.3

• Any player who has played the majority of their season in a higher grade/division will not be eligible to play in a lower grade/division in the Finals series, including their nominated team. Rationale is that there was no restriction from registering more players in lower grades & having them play up into the A grade team every week, to stack a lower grade team come finals.

# Judiciary & Grievance – Changes for 2023

#### • Temporary dismissal added.

**Rationale:** For all grades except BPL, DIV1, WPL & WDIV1 any player who receives a yellow card for dissent will receive a temporary dismissal. For all Junior Competitions dismissal time is 5 minutes & for all Senior Competitions dismissal time will be 10 minutes. Further information & guidance for clubs to follow in the new year.

#### **Specific Rule Reference: 7**

#### • Inclusion of FNSW appeal workflow.

*Rationale: Previously the appeals process was Judiciary – Appeals – Board of CCF, a change introduced due to the FNSW disaffiliation movement. New process Judiciary – Appeals – FNSW.*

• Yellow card accumulation no longer carrying into final series for BPL, WPL, Div 1 & WDiv1. Rationale – significant club feedback that 5 in 18 games represents a challenge.

### **Specific Rule Reference: 6.3**

• Addition of Specific requirements for Referee attendance at Judiciary. Rationale many cases where clubs wanted further questioning around a match official report – this gives an avenue for requesting that in specific circumstances.

# **Specific Rule Reference: 7.4**

• Addition of ability to publish determinations. To expose and create transparency around the tribunal process and consistency. After the expiry of any relevant appeal period any Determination may be published by CCF on its website
